Davidson Offensive Player Of The Game

Junior left tackle Nate Brode was selected as the offensive player of the game. In the league opener Nate's blocking helped the offense roll up 417 yards rushing against the Tigers. Nate and his offensive line teammates took over the game in the 2nd half as the Cards outscored Howland 21-0.

Davidson's Defensive Player Of The Game
