

Players Of The Game vs Salem

Davidson Offensive Player Of The Game

Senior tight end Chris Ulery was selected as the Offensive Player of The Game. He graded out at 94% for the evening against a very good Salem defense. Chris has been one of the solid contributors upfront that has allowed the offense to average close to 300 yards rushing per game and 375 total yards per contest.

Davidson's Defensive Player Of The Game

Senior Free Safety Angelo Babbro turned in an outstanding performance against the best offense in a three county area. Angelo returned an interception 64 yards for a TD, and caused 2 fumbles. Angelo was instrumental in helping hold the Quaker offense to 89 total yards.

Davidson's Special Teams Player Of The Game

Kicker Adam Jones was selected as the special teams player of the game for his performance against Salem. Adam was 5/5 on extra points and converted a 32 yard field goal in the 4th quarter to extend the Cards lead to 38-9. Adam also had a touchdown saving tackle on a kick-off.

Sophomore tailback Pat Fening earned this award with his outstanding effort last week in preparing our defense for Salem. Going into week 7 Salem had the leading rusher in our league. Pat gave a great look to our defense in helping them get ready for the Quakers. Due to Pat's efforts, the defense held Salem to 57 yards rushing and 89 total yards.

McDonald's Offensive Player of The Game

Junior two year starter Justin Bonanno earned this week's award with another solid effort from his right guard position. Justin had a tremendous night blocking against the best defense we have seen thus far. Justin and his teammates upfront helped the Cards amass 415 yards in total offense.
