

Players Of The Game vs Chaney

Davidson Offensive Player Of The Game

Averaging 16.5 yards per attempt, senior tailback Angelo Babbaro once again earned the Offensive Player of The Game. He also was awarded the Fox 17/62 player of the game. Behind a dominating performance by the offensive line, Angelo gained 182 yards rushing, scored 3 TD's. He also had a touchdown reception.

Davidson's Defensive Player Of The Game

Senior Co-Captain Kyle Banna was awarded the Defensive Player of The Game for his outstanding effort against Chaney. Kyle was credited with 7 tackles, 1 tackle for a loss, 1 QB sack, and a pass break up.

Davidson's Special Teams Player Of The Game

Senior kicker Adam Jones went 5-6 on extra points versus the Cowboys last Friday evening. He also put 3 of his 8 kick-offs into the endzone limiting a potent Cowboy return team to poor field position all evening.

Davidson's Practice Player Of The Week

Returning to action for the first time this year, Sophomore QB Mark Carrocce was awarded the practice player of the week award. By imitating Chaney QB Antwan Rice, Mark gave the defense fits all week in practice. His efforts helped prepare our "D" for an explosive Chaney offense.

McDonald's Offensive Player of The Game

Senior center Nick Rousher played the best game of his career. A three year starter at center, Nick achieved a 100% grade for his performance against Chaney. His play and that of his teammates upfront allowed the Cards to rush for 317 yards on only 38 carries. This effort allowed the Cards to roll to a 49-7 lead with 11:39 seconds remaining in the 3rd quarter.

McDonald's Defensive Player of The Game

Senior Co-Captain Joe Rosko recorded a team high 11 tackles in the Cardinals first ever regular season win over the Chaney Cowboys.
